Ms. Constance N. Tiller currently serves as the Branch Chief for the Engineering & Construction Training Branch (ECTB) of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Learning Center (ULC), located on Redstone Arsenal, Huntsville, Alabama. She is responsible for executing the full range of resources, workforce management & financial responsibilities of the branch. With an estimated annual budget of \$12M with a staff of 13 employees. She is responsible for managing all training products developed for the training branch. She is responsible for managing and ensuring execution of training for over 7,800 students within the yearly training cycle.



She effectively communicates the vision and directives of the USACE Learning Center to employees and all stakeholders. She manages and executes a dynamic ECTB program which offers just under 160 courses and nearly 200 sessions annually in the subject of Engineering, Project Management and Military Leadership. She formulates ever increasing training goals by analyzing current and proposed operational requirements; develops current and long-range objectives for accomplishment of program goals; and adjusting or refining objectives in a dynamic training environment. She manages her team with commitment, dedication, customer service, integrity and finding solutions and innovative approaches to training a dynamic workforce.

Ms. Tiller has been employed at the USACE Learning Center since 2011 and has grown through the ranks serving in nearly every position within the organization. She initially managed over 17 contract courses and worked diligently to bring the contract courses in-house, providing a cost savings to the organization and the government. She has been instrumental in defining procedures and processes to better meet the needs of the course design and development phase. She has been responsible for engaging and initiating the process of new course development for a record number of courses within ECTB. Her tenacity to provide excellent support to the organization has been steadfast. Her capacity prior to joining the USACE Learning Center displayed a large breadth of management and organizational skills. She worked for radio,

television and print media for over 25 years. In her last role in this field she served as Program Manager for a contractor to NASA for over 20 years. She was responsible for Day-To-Day operations of the full Marshall Space Flight Center Multimedia department, managing over 50 employees and an annual budget of over \$28M.

She is actively involved in Community Service and worked for several national and local non-profit organizations. She was responsible for creating and developing volunteer opportunities to meet the needs of the underserved and youth of the county. Under her management tenure she increased the number of volunteers and activities to an all time record. She was presented with the Community Changemaker award presented by Gen.
